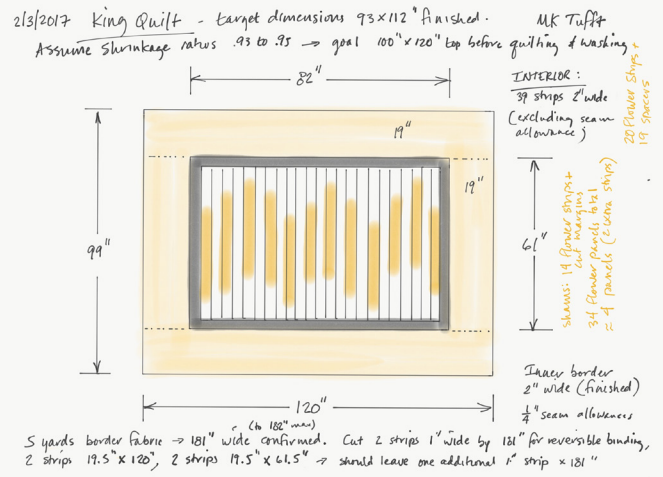


Dog bed quilt (above), with easy zipper opening

1. Sketch your quilt - final dimensions, borders, pieced section - determine how many strips you will need (2" finished, assume 1/4" seams)
2. Pick your panel, square your edges and cut 2.5" wide strips
3. Choose your coordinating fabrics & plan your stagger
4. Piece using walking foot for straight seams, allow extra ~2" to trim square



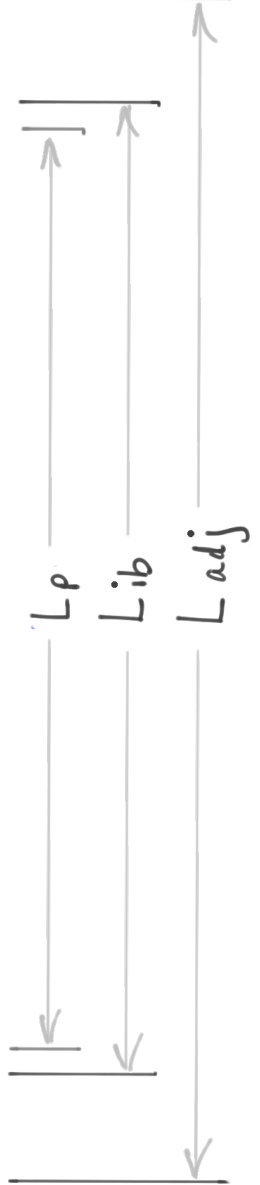
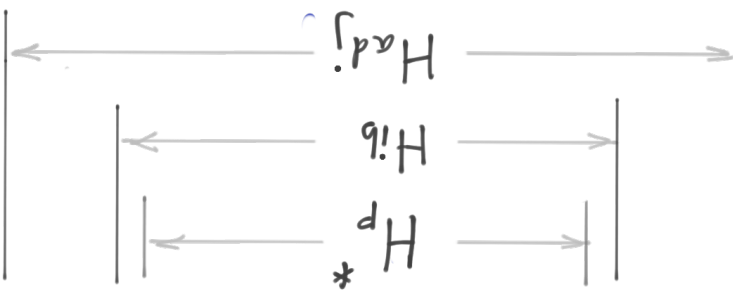
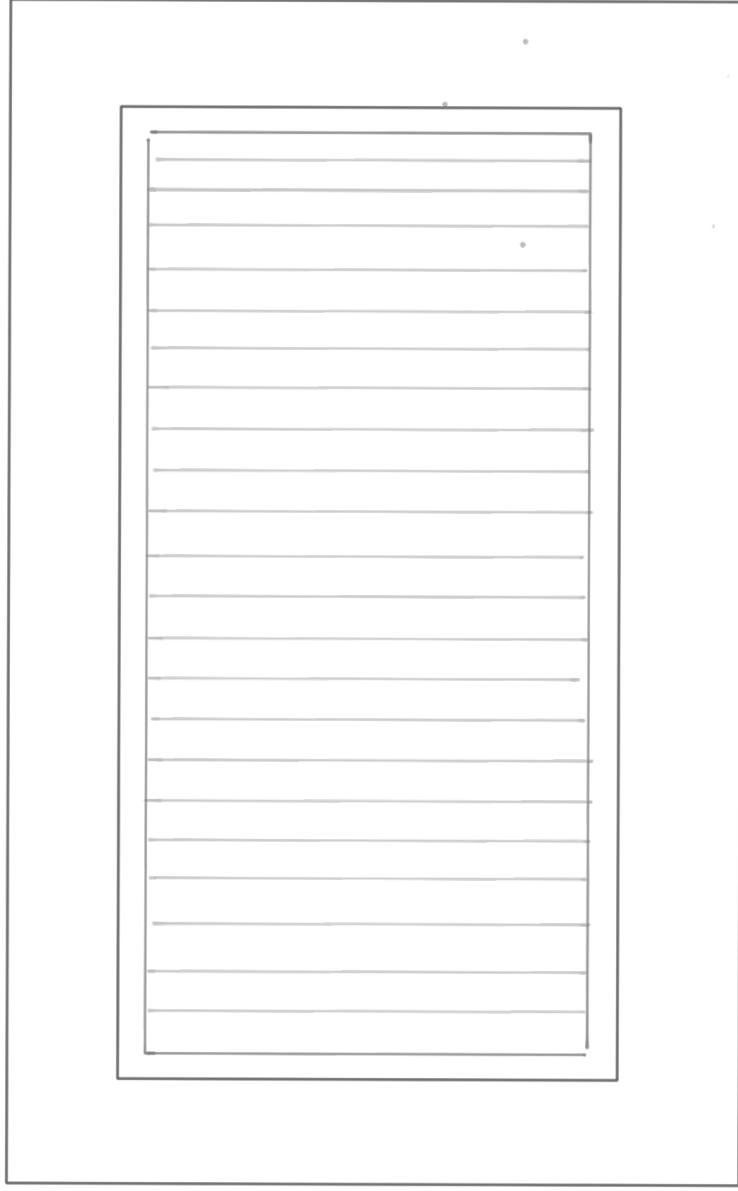
Quilts shrink from quilting & washing... if dimensions are critical, scale up your dimensions by 5-9%.
